





SPEECH OF THE NATIONAL PRESIDENT

 BEING THE SPEECH OF THE NATIONAL PRESIDENT OF UNIFEMGA ON THE OCCASION OF HER 2025 ANNUAL REUNION PROGRAM (OAU Ile Ife, Saturday 10th May, 2025/12th Dhu'l-Qi'dah 1446 A.H)

All Praise is due to Allah, Al-Mubdi (The Originator), Al-Wahhab (The Bestower), Al-Wakeel (The Director of Affairs), Al Waarith (The Inheritor), Al-Qadir (The All Powerful). He is the Originator of all that exist and bestows to whom He wills, He Direct the affairs of all, and will inherit everything, and is able to return life to all.

May His peace and blessings be upon the seal of all Prophets, Muhammad (SAW), his household, companions, and all who follow the pristine teachings of Islam till the Day of Qiyamah.

Protocols.

Alhamdulillah rabil aalamin. It has pleased Allah to gather us for our Annual Reunion programme this year . A lot has happened in the intervening period. We have recorded successes and failures as individuals, as a body, as a community, Nation, and the world. We are nearly half way through the current Presidential tenure (2023-2027) in Nigeria.

As a nation, we are grappling with the reconfiguration of our economy via the removal of Petrol and FOREX Subsidy. There are indications that our economy is on the rebound but the gloom as a result of Inflation continues to be the most talked about topic nationwide. The new Administration in the USA has again brought us all to the reality that the world is very inter-connected. We pray to Allah to bless our efforts as a Nation to be able to make better use of our resources and offer our services and products in exchange for those of other countries.

The topic of this year's reunion lecture, being the 20th edition is: **"Cross border trade implications to Nigeria's economy"**.

Hopefully, this topic and others in this reunion would serve as our contribution to educate the populace on the urgency for Nigeria to strive to be self-sufficient and produce as much as we need internally. This would reduce and /or eliminate frivolous importation into the country.

The President of the United States upon assumption of office on 20th January 2025 signed a number of Executive Orders in what is now tagged America's "Liberation Day". These Executive Orders were intended to foster the economic independence and security of the United States and sought to achieve the following objectives:

1. Protect the United States from Foreign Terrorists and other National Security and Public Safety Threats.
2. Protect the Meaning and Value of American Citizenship.
3. Secure American Borders and Declaration of National Emergency at the High Risk border regions of the United States

4. Declare an America First Trade Policy.

5. Executive Order that protects the American People against Invasion.

6. Executive Order that guarantees State protections against Invasion.

The execution of many of the above orders have been widely condemned, but it is unanimously accepted that the above policy thrust should be the same guiding any Nations like Nigeria, seeking to get out of its precarious Economic and Security situation. The topic for this year's programme is thus very germane. Trade policies must protect our local economy from excessive importation, empower our local business to export and ensure the provision of adequate security to the citizens in their homeland.

Allah makes it clear that Man is created to be dependent on one another and thus the need for local and international free trade. Nigerian must identify the benefits that can be obtained within the federating units (states). This would enable the citizens to relate better locally which can then translate into better relations with other countries within and outside Africa.

mercy of your Lord? It is We who have apportioned among them their livelihood in the life of this world and have raised some of them above others in degrees [of rank] that they may make use of one another for service. But the mercy of your Lord is better than whatever they accumulate".

There are at the minimum 5 policy initiatives which I believe would be our recommendation from this conference. They are as follows:

1. Define and implement a Nigeria First Trade Policy. The prevailing situation where Nigerians are not encouraged to eat and wear what is produced locally should be highly discouraged. We must continuously look inwards for home grown alternatives - **Nigeria Public Procurement Act 2007**

2. Implementation of a firm citizens identification system to track/identify all citizens and visitor's resident in the country. This senseless killings in Plateau, Benue and other volatile states would come to an end with such a policy. Review of the **National Identity Management Commission Act. 2007** to give it more bite and effect.

3. Development of a national Value system that would be vigorously pursued and upheld by all. The national quota system has been constantly abused and the criticism of the current President's appointment is also an indication of a failed or failing Value system - See the **National Ethics and Integrity Policy** approved by Federal Executive Council (FEC) in 2020 and how to take this further.

4. Implementation of an International and local immigration system where movement of residents is known. This will reduce the issue of unknown bandits/herdsmen, and terrorism drastically. There is need to review the ECOWAS Trade Liberalization Scheme (ETLS), that established free trade area across the region and eliminated tariffs and non-tariff barriers among member states. The free movement of goods and persons, and duty-free trade must not be to the detriment of our people.

5. Executive Order protecting Nigerians against invasion. All border areas should be properly identified and marked. Need to revisit the **National Security Strategy 2019** that was drafted to ensure that Nigeria's sovereignty, territorial integrity, and the well-being of the people and the country's institutions are preserved, protected and enhanced.

The issue of minorities in many states being ignored or overlooked should be stopped. Just as there is need for Federal representation, there must be the implementation of ethnic minority representation even in the states.

Members of UNIFEMGA attained so much success in the period from the last reunion to now. These will continue to be recognized and celebrated via our annual Honor's Day Programme.

At the last count, about Seventy million Naira (N70m) has been collected for the self-funding Scholarship Foundation target of One Hundred Million Naira (N100m). We are having to revise our Foundation target to Two Hundred and Fifty Million Naira (N250m) to cater for the annual Scholarship and reunion to become near self-funding. We thus have a target to raise about One Hundred and Seventy-Five Million Naira (N175m) to keep us away from annual request for donations. With effect from next year, we would implement a mandatory percentage saving from donors and recipients of scholarship award into the Scholarship Foundation fund. This would ensure that recipients realize the value of savings and investment. Volunteerism would be instituted into the Scholarship scheme to make recipients also contribute their own quota.



Alhaji Bashir Adewale Adeniyi (MFR) is the Comptroller General of the Nigeria Customs Service. He was conferred with the national honour of Member of the Order of the Federal Republic (MFR) by Former President Muhammadu Buhari on October 11, 2022.

Adeniyi joined the Nigeria Customs Service, rose to become Deputy Comptroller of Customs in 2012, and served as the Customs National Public Relations Officer (Headquarters Abuja) among other duties.

He was appointed Comptroller of Customs in April 2017, and later appointed Deputy Commandant of the Nigeria Customs Command and Staff College Gwagwalada, Abuja.

Adeniyi became Assistant Comptroller General in February 2020, and supervised the seizure of \$8.07 million cash being illegally taken out of Nigeria through the E-Wing of the international airport tarmac.

He was appointed as the Commandant of the Nigeria Customs Command and Staff College Gwagwalada, Abuja. In January 2023, he became the Acting Deputy Comptroller-General of the Nigeria Customs Service (NCS) and later, in June 2023, was appointed as the Acting Comptroller General of the Nigeria Customs Service (NCS) by President Bola Ahmed Tinubu.







The following are the highlights of some of the chapter's programmes:





UNIFEMGA SCHOLARSHIP UPDATE

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The Obafemi Awolowo University Muslim Graduates' Association (UNIFEMGA) is the Alumni association of Muslim graduates from Obafemi Awolowo University, Ile Ife. It was established in 2002 with the goal of fostering the spiritual and economic development of its members through religious reminders and networking. Recognizing the importance of giving back to their Alma Mater and the Muslim community at the University, which has consistently supported individual students and the Muslim Students Society (MSS), the group has undertaken several significant projects over the years.

These efforts include the completion of the Ultra-Modern Central Mosque, which had been abandoned for over fifteen years, the refurbishment of hostel masjids, and the establishment of a Nursery and Primary Islamic School in Ile-Ife. This school offers both Islamic and contemporary education to the children of staff and non-staff Muslims in the Ife township. Additionally, the association has provided hostel facilities to Muslim students to help alleviate the accommodation challenges often faced on campus and has implemented a scholarship scheme for indigent and brilliant students.

FUNDING

The Scholarship Scheme is primarily funded through donations from members, both individuals and member Chapters. Non-members also contribute to the Fund. These funds are solicited annually from Chapters, while individuals sometimes make deposits that cover multiple years. Individual members specify the number of students they wish to sponsor and may indicate preferences for the type of students, such as indigent, merit-based, or girls' education. The funds are managed by a dedicated Board of Trustees, which includes Professors from the University community and Senior Executive members of the Association.

As the Scholarship Scheme has expanded over the years, the Association has recognized the importance of partnering with individuals and institutions that are passionate about scholarship and humanitarian services. These partnerships will allow more deserving students to benefit from the scheme. Below is a summary of students who have received scholarships from the fund since the 2008/09 academic year. Since its inception, approximately N88.75 million has been disbursed through the scholarship programme.

In the 2023/2024 academic session, we increased the annual award from N75,000 to N100,000 for the undergraduate category and N120,000 to N150,000 for postgraduate category.

For this year (2024/2025) edition of the scholarship, we are disbursing a total of N12.2m for 118 scholars.

We are also organising human capital development programmes for the scholars such as periodic training, lectures and workshops to compliment the scholarship award granted to the students.

Our current investment and cash on hand stands at N24.52 million, and we have a commitment of \$30,000 (N48 million) from UNIFEMGA North America. This brings our endowment to a total of N73,452,576, leaving us with a gap of N126,457,424 to achieve our N200 million target.


