IN THE NAME OF ALLAH, THE MOST GRACIOUS, THE MOST MERCIFUL

Praise be to Allah, Lord of all the Worlds. May the Peace and Blessings of Allah be upon the Prophet, Muhammad (saw), his family, his companions, and all followers of his pristine message and guidance till the day of judgement.

Being the speech of the National President of UNIFEMGA on the occasion of the 5th Annual National Program on Agriculture, organized by the Ogun State chapter of UNIFEMGA.

As-salaam alaykum warahmotullahi wabarakatuhu.

Distinguished special guests, respected guests, esteemed members and stakeholders in the agricultural sector, I welcome you all to this auspicious occasion. We are again blessed this year with the opportunity to deliberate on issues and future of Agricultural practices in Nigeria. This year's theme in the series of seminars and workshops organized by Ogun State chapter is tagged:

"Role of individuals in improving Food Quality, Nutritional Value and Potential Income Generation". *The specific topic for today is: "Home Gardening: A Pathway to food Security and Economic Empowerment"*

The above theme and topic are ever relevant, especially with the economic realities of today. My little research into Home Gardening in Nigeria made me realize there are quite a number of support platforms, NGOs, and Government incentives out there, waiting for us to tap into. When you grow your vegetables, you can be sure of the quality of water used to water them or the feed you give to your poultry – that is quality management, assured nutritional value, savings on expense, and potential income from selling the produce of your garden. It teaches our children responsibility and gives them a sense of pride and dignity of being productive in society. When our community markets realize that we have alternatives, the market would naturally reflect this with lower pricing.

The expected outcome of today's lecture is for us to be better informed and equipped to lead by example and drive positive change in our communities. We must all imbibe and practicalize home gardening, enhance food security for our homes, and promote sustainable living, as the positive environmental impact is also something that we all must be part of.

We must always explore how to contribute our own quota to the economy, in a sustainable, innovative, and efficient manner. The idea that something small, like starting a home garden, can have much larger effects, such as inspiring your children to greatness, is called the butterfly effect. The life of Prophet Musa provides an example, as his simple act of helping the ladies water their flock led to him being offered a wife and a new life in Madyan.

And when he came to the well of Madyan, he found there a crowd of people watering [their flocks], and he found aside from them two women driving back [their flocks]. He said, "What is your circumstance?" They said, "We do not water until the shepherds dispatch [their flocks]; and our father is an old man." Q.28:23

Considering the escalating cost of food and the unwholesome practices by many in the quest to make money we must utilize the free spaces around homes and offices for agricultural purposes. Nigeria currently does limited farming outside of the wet season and this should not be a problem with home gardening, which can usually be sustained throughout the year. The potential savings and income could be quite substantial.

Prof. Adewale Waheed SALAU is a renowned Horticultural and cropping system expert, with 22 years' experience.

He was born in Mushin, Lagos State of Nigeria about 61 years ago. He had his early education at Jehovah Jireh primary school, Mushin in 1970. When his parents relocated to Ibadan, he attended Baptist Day School, Oke-Ado, Ibadan, Oyo state from 1971 to 1974 and later St Luke Primary School, Japara Ijebu-Igbo, from 1974 to 1975, where he emerged as the overall best student in Primary 6. He attended Molusi College, Ijebu-Igbo for the secondary education from 1975 to 1980. He worked briefly as sales clerk with his uncle, before proceeding to the Federal Polytechnic Bida, Niger State where he obtained National Diploma in Agricultural Engineering in 1986 and thereafter, University of Agriculture, Abeokuta where he obtained Bachelor of Agriculture (Crop Production) in 1992; Master of Agriculture (Crop production) in 1999 and Doctor of Philosophy degree in Horticulture in 2010.

Professor Salau worked as a Farm Manager during the NYSC programme in Hong Local Government of Adamawa State in 1993; as Finance officer in a Finance House in Osogbo, Osun State in 1995, and as a Research Assistant in a World Bank Assisted Project from 1996 to 1999.

Professor Salau joined the services of the Federal University of Agriculture, Abeokuta in October, 2003 as Assistant Lecturer and rose through the ranks to become Professor of Horticulture in October, 2018. He taught many undergraduate and postgraduate courses. He had served as the Head, Department of Horticulture from 2017 to 2019 and the Deputy Dean, College of Plant Science and Crop Production of the University from 2023 to 2025. He also served as external examiner, postgraduate for Federal University of Technology, Akure from 2024 till date.

His research focused on cropping system/olericulture. He has over 40 Journal articles comprising of 38 in both local and international journal and about 10 in referred conference proceedings. In the course of his career, he had supervised and graduated over 80 undergraduate, 20 Master of Agriculture and 5 doctoral students. He is a member of many professional bodies. He is happily married to Mrs Khadijah A. Salau and the marriage is blessed with 4 children.

Prof. AYINDE, Idris Akanbi is a lecturer/consultant/researcher with 27 years' cognate experience in academic and developmental research, project management and social services.

Prof. Ayinde began his western education career at the Army Children School, Mokola, Ibadan between 1971 and 1977. He then proceeded for his secondary school education at Ahmadiyya (now Anwar-ul-Islam) Grammar School, Ibadan from 1977 to 1982. His search for knowledge as an educationist spurred him to Oyo (now Osun) State College of Education, Ilesa from 1984 to 1987; where he graduated as the overall best in his College (With 14 points out of 15). After, he proceeded to the Federal University of Agriculture, Abeokuta (UNAAB) where he obtained his Bachelor of Agriculture degree in the Department of Agricultural Economics and Farm Management (AE&FM) with a second class upper (honours) division in 1994; Master of Agriculture in Agricultural Economics in 1999 and Doctor of Philosophy (PhD) Agricultural Economics, in 2004.

Prof Ayinde completed his Quran at a young age. He attended the Markaz-ul-Uluum, wa luggatul Ar'robiyya of the late Sheikh Abubakar Al-Ilory at Adamasingba, Ibadan (May Allah rest his soul in peace). Prof. Ayinde was made the Assistant School Imam during his secondary school day (1981-1982). One of the Imams at the College of Agriculture, Oyo (Now Osun) State, College of Agriculture, Abeokuta (1985-1987). He became the Deputy Chief Imam of the University of Agriculture, Abeokuta (1998-2007) and later became the Chief Imam of the University from 2007 till date.

He is currently a Professor of Production and Environmental Economics in the Department of Agricultural Economics and Farm Management, Federal University of Agriculture, Abeokuta, Nigeria. Prof. Ayinde is widely travelled and has participated in several international and national conferences/workshops as presenter and resource person.

Professor Ayinde is a Fellow of the Farm Management Association of Nigeria and a Fellow and Life Member of the Nigerian Agricultural Association of Agricultural Economists (NAAE), and he is the Editor-in Chief of the Nigerian Journal of Agricultural Economics.

Prof. Ayinde has one hundred and thirty (129) publications, comprising 92 journal articles 4 chapters in book, 32 refereed proceedings, 1 documentary video, among others. He has supervised over 200 undergraduate students; 34 postgraduate students out of which 7 were PhDs (Six additional are ongoing) and 27 were Masters (with 16 ongoing). He is a reviewer for many reputable national and international journals. Professor Ayinde is a recipient of 15 commendation letters from the University Management. He was the editor of one of the University-based Journal (Journal of Humanities, Social Sciences and Creative Arts [JHSSCA])

Prof. Ayinde is married to Alhaja Professor Adefunke Fadilat O. Ayinde and Mrs. Monsurat Adunni Ayinde, and they are blessed with Children.

Wisdom

BEHIND THE LEGISLATION OF

Zaakat



It should be noted that Allaah does not prescribe anything that is not for the best reasons and does not achieve the best interests. Allaah is the All-Knowing, Who encompasses all things by His knowledge, and He is the All-Wise Who does not prescribe anything except for a reason.

With regard to the reason behind the prescription of Zakah , the scholars have mentioned many reasons for it, including the following:

- To complete and perfect a person's Islam, because it is one of the pillars of Islam. If a person fulfils it, his Islam is complete. Undoubtedly this is an important aim for every Muslim, and every believing Muslim will strive to perfect his faith.
- It is indicative of a person's sincerity of faith, because wealth is dear to people, and something that is loved will not be given up except for something that is equally or more loved, or rather for something that is more loved. Hence it is called Sadaqah, because it is indicative of the sincerity (sidq) of a person's desire to please Allah, may He be exalted.
- It cleanses the character of the one who gives it, so that he is saved from being a miser and is included among the generous, because if he accustoms himself to giving, whether it is giving knowledge or giving wealth or using his position to help others, that giving will become a characteristic for him and will be part of his nature, until he gets upset if there is a day when he does not give. Like the hunter who gets used to hunting, if one day he does not hunt, you will find him feeling anxious. Similarly the one who has gotten used to being generous will feel anxious if he does not give some of his wealth or use his position to help others one day.
- It makes the Muslim society like a single family, in which those who have the means show compassion to those who do not have the means, and the rich to those who are in hardship. Thus a person feels that he has brothers to whom he must do good as Allaah has been good to him. Allaah says (interpretation of the meaning):

“and do good as Allaah has been good to you” [al-Qasas 28:77]

So the Muslim ummah becomes like a single family. This is what is known nowadays as “social security”, but Zakaah is better than that, because a person is paying it as an obligatory duty and benefitting his brothers thereby.

- It prevents financial crimes such as robbery and stealing and the like, because the poor will get enough to meet their needs, and they will excuse the rich because they are giving them some of their wealth, and they will see that they are treating them well, so they will not transgress against them.
- Salvation from the heat of the Day of Resurrection. The Prophet (peace and blessings of Allaah be upon him) said: "Every man will be in the shade of his charity on the Day of Resurrection." Classed as saheeh by al-Albaani in Saheeh al-Jaami' (4510). And he listed among those whom Allaah will shade with His shade on the Day when there will be no shade but His: "... a man who gives charity and conceals it so much that his left hand does not know what his right hand is doing." Agreed upon.
- It expiates for sins. The Messenger (peace and blessings of Allaah be upon him) said: "Charity extinguishes sins as water extinguishes fire." Classed as Saheeh by al-Albaani in Saheeh al-Jaami', 5136.


